REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ITOGON

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitutional provision that mandates the government to promote the quality of life of the people, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that local government units shall pursue undertakings to improve and maintain peace and order, among other equally significant concerns;

WHEREAS, consistent with Executive Order No. 309, series of 1988 as amended, section 116 of the Local Government Code provides for the establishment of local peace and order council in every province, city and municipality;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reorganize the composition of the Municipal Peace and Order Council to complete its membership which were left vacant due to transfer of assignments, cessation from office and other compelling reasons of some members;

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, ATTY. VICTORIO T. PALANGDAN, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Itogon, Benguet Province, hereby reorganize the Municipal Peace and Order Council as follows:

Section 1. Composition. The Municipal Peace and Order Council shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Functions. In accordance with EO 309, series of 1988, the Municipal Peace and Order Council shall perform the following functions:

1. Provide a forum for dialogue and deliberation of major issues and problems affecting peace and order, including insurgency;
2. Recommend measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety in the locality, including anti-insurgency measures;
3. Initiate and/or oversee the convergence and orchestration of internal security operations efforts of civil authorities and agencies, military and police;
4. Apply moral situation to and/or recommend sanctions against local chief executives who are giving material and political support to communist rebels;
5. Monitor the provision of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects in remote rural and indigenous population areas to isolate them from the communist rebels' "Agitate/ arouse, Organize and Mobilize" and ideological, political and organization work;

6. Perform other functions assigned by law, the President or the National Peace and Order Council.


Section 3. Secretariat: The secretariat shall be composed of the following:

Section 4. Repealing Clause. All Administrative Orders and/or Issuances inconsistent herewith or parts hereof are deemed repealed and/or modified accordingly.

Section 5. Effectivity. This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately.
