EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 19 Series of 2024

REOGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ITOGON.

WHEREAS, Article 3, section 13 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being;

WHEREAS, Chapter III, section 23 of the Sanguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015 provides that "To ensure wider and multi-sectoral youth participation in local governance, there shall be in every province, city or municipality a Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) which shall be called Provincial Youth Development Council, City Youth Development Council and Municipal Youth Development Council, respectively. The LYDC shall be composed of representatives of youth and youth-serving organizations in the provincial, city and municipal levels. The LYDC shall assist in the planning and execution of projects and programs of the Sanguniang Kabataan, and the Pederasyon in all levels;"

WHEREAS, in line with the State policies and objectives as provided in Section 2 of R.A 10742, as amended, the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of said law seeks to better empower the Sanguniang Kabataan to fulfill the mandate of providing representation to the youth and serve as venues for young people to directly participate in the day-to-day affairs, as well as the long-term improvement of the communities;

WHEREAS, consistent with the pertinent provisions of R.A. 10742, as amended by R.A. 11768, and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2017-26, the Local Chief Executive designated a Youth Development Officer to perform the duties and functions prescribed under the said law and issuance relative to the organization and functionality of the Local Youth Development Council;

NOW THEREFORE, I, BERNARD S. WACLIN, by virtue of the powers vested in as Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Itogon, Benguet Province hereby REORGANIZE the Municipal Youth Development Council of the Municipality of Itogon as follows:

Section 1. <u>Composition/Organizational Structure</u>. (a) Consistent with Rule III, section 24(i) of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 10742, as amended, the Municipal Youth Development Council of the Municipality of Itogon shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. *Duties and Functions of the LYDC* – The LYDC shall discharge the following duties and functions:

- 1. Serve as the core of the advocacy on youth participation in nation-building and youth empowerment;
- 2. Finalize the three (3) year Local Youth Development Plan that is anchored in the Provincial Youth Development Plan and the development plans of the local government units. The LYDP shall be initially drafted by the respective SK Pederasyon and shall be finalized by the LYDC. This shall be submitted to the LCE for inclusion in the Local Development Plan and subsequently endorsed to the Sanggunian of the local government unit concerned for approval. These plans shall give priority to programs, projects and activities that will promote and ensure the meaningful youth participation in nation-building, sustainable youth development and empowerment, equitable access to quality education, environmental protection, climate change adaptation, disaster risk reduction and resiliency, youth employment and livelihood, health and anti-drug abuse, gender sensitivity, social protection, capability building and sports development;
- 3. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Youth Development Plan; and
- 4. Perform such other functions as may be prescribed by law or ordinance.

Section 3. Convening of the LYDC – In accordance with the revised Implementing Rules of R.A. 10742, as amended, the Chairman of the LYDC shall convene the council and shall preside over all its meetings.

Section 4. *Meetings and Quorum*. - (1) The LYDC shall schedule a meeting every quarter, and as often as needed. However, if the president or the vice president of the SK Pederasyon of the Municipality fails to convene the LYDC as scheduled, at least one-third of the total membership of the LYDC may call for a meeting. In both instances, a written notice shall be sent, either through traditional or non-traditional means, to all members,

setting the date, time, place and agenda of the meeting which must be received at least two (2) days in advance.

(2) The presence of the majority of all members of the LYDC shall constitute a quorum.

Section 5. Secretariat. Mr Lincoln P. Ponase as the designated Local Youth Development Office shall serve as Secretariat to the Municipal Youth Development Council. As such, he shall perform the duties and function appurtenant thereto as prescribed under Administrative Order No. 11-2024 and all applicable laws, rules and regulations.

Section 6. <u>Repealing Clause.</u> All Orders and executive issuances inconsistent with this ORDER or parts hereof are deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. <u>Separability Clause.</u> If for any reason this Order or parts hereof is declared invalid or unconstitutional by court or other offices of competent authorities, other parts not affected by such declaration shall remain valid and effective.

Section8. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately.
